

Gen. 29:31-35 Now Yahveh saw that Leah was unloved, and He opened her womb, but Rachel was barren. And Leah conceived and bore a son and named him **Reuben**, for she said, "Because Yahveh has seen my affliction; surely now my husband will love me." 33 Then she conceived again and bore a son and said, "Because Yahveh has heard that I am unloved, He has therefore given me this son also." So she named him **Simeon**. And she conceived again and bore a son and said, "Now this time my husband will become attached to me, because I have borne him three sons." Therefore he was named **Levi.** 35 And she conceived again and bore a son and said, "This time I will praise Yahveh." Therefore she named him **Judah**. Then she stopped bearing.

Here we see the sons of Leah and Jacob listed. If you take the meanings of each of these names and put them together in the order which they were born, you will see a beautiful phrase that is called the "Gospel of Leah". Reuben means "son". Simeon means "Hearing". Levi means "joining". Judah means "praise". Now use your imagination for a moment and imagine Leah calling out for her boys. She is saying: "Through the Son I will hear the word of Yah, I will be joined to Him and give Him praise".
