GHOSTS

WHAT ARE GHOSTS, WHERE DO THEY COME FROM?

Ghosts are real! Ghosts are spirits of dead secular people that have escaped from the unsaved side of Hades, in the second Heaven. Their soul/heart is kept in a special place in Hades till Yeshua comes back when the souls and spirits of all will be joined to prepare for the final judgment. The souls and spirits in Hades, are not held there by force. If someone on earth (with demons) wants to call them back, eg.. (seance), these spirits may come back as ghosts for as long as they please.

WHAT DO GHOSTS LOOK LIKE?



Ghosts look exactly as the unsaved person appeared the moment they died. They remain the age that they died at. For example, a man shot with a gun; his ghost would appear as such. A woman dying in bed of a stroke, may appear with a nightgown on because she was in bed.

They take on the exact celestial size of the person they came from. Ghosts don't have physical bodies, because ghosts are only spirits, as per Luke 24:39.

WHAT DO THEY DO HERE ON EARTH?

They normally return to where they once lived. They usually take on the name (if you will), of the person they were part of at one time. They stick around and are a nuisance in most cases simply because no one wants or knows how to deal with them. They have no legal right to be there.

DESCRIBE THE PERSONALITY OF A GHOST

Ghosts, because they are spirit only, are very self centered. They care about one thing only, and that is themselves. Ghosts have no emotions, no mercy, no compassion, no pity.

They have their favorite locations, (houses, bars, meeting places, beds), chairs, etc., like

humans. They are particularly fond of messy places, abandoned buildings, and cluttered up yards.

When asked about their family and friends, ghosts will tell you that they really don't care much about them.

If asked their opinion, they will speak to you in the same manner as most secular people.

Ghosts are just as curious about things as most humans.

Generally speaking, because they have no heart or soul, ghosts couldn't care less about heaven or hell. They will take whatever is coming to them, and they pretty much know where they will end up.

WHAT KIND OF THINGS DO GHOSTS DO?

Ghosts are like children. They want to be noticed. They do things to annoy people, so as to get their attention, even though they know that the people cannot see them. They are often fascinated with turning on and off light switches in the night, opening and closing refrigerator doors in the dark, dropping things to make a noise, moving things, etc..

MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION ABOUT GHOSTS

Ghosts don't feel temperature, but can sense it. Some ghosts like it in a house that is very warm, and some like the cold.

There is no such thing as a ghost from a saved person.

If an unsaved alter is up when a person dies, you have the extremely rare situation of a ghost of an alter.

Angels don't like ghosts and want nothing to do with them.

Angels can see ghosts, but ghosts can't see angels.

Ghosts like to do their strange things mostly at night when no one can interfere.

Ghosts can often be found near military facilities, the camaraderie developed in military life and extreme war type situations seems to remain even after death.

Older ghosts have problems seeing just as they did in their natural life.

A ghost who likes certain food, booze, etc., can symbolically eat or drink it if you provide him with it. Ghosts never sleep.

Ghosts can't see demons or angels, but can see some alters.

HOW DO YOU GET RID OF THEM?

For an anointed person, getting rid of ghosts is a relatively easy task. Only someone who is truly a Believer, baptized in the Holy Spirit, has the power and authority to send ghosts back to Hades. Yahveh uses such a person as a vessel to remove the ghosts and allows Angels to deal with them. They can be taken back to Hades by Angels once they are identified in person, and acknowledged. It takes a special discernment/ anointing for one to deal with ghosts. This is a rare gift indeed.
