

INFANT BAPTISM OF SPRINKLING



Infant baptism is simply not Biblical, it is Satan's invention to make people believe that they are on their way to heaven. It is done frequently in Christian churches around the world, just another example of just how far Religions like them are from the truth of the Bible.

Baptism is well known and recognized as a "regeneration" of ones self in the Roman Catholic Church and many others pagan religious organizations. This same regeneration concept is used also for holy water. To the Roman Catholic church, baptism is "of absolute necessity for salvation", insomuch as even infants dying without it cannot be admitted to heaven. When the Roman Catholic priest talks about infant baptism, he explains to the parents of the innocent child that baptism is absolutely necessary for the child's salvation, and if the baby isn't baptized, it simply cannot go to heaven. Unknown to the parents, the ancient Satanic ceremony of sacrificing the babies to Baal using oil and salt, will now be applied to their child, exposing this innocent baby to the secret agents, demons of Babylon and Satan.



The priest claims he must exorcise the baby of demon forces to protect it. He then puts the occult mark of Tammuz on the babies head with oil (the sign of the cross). Then he puts salt in the baby's mouth and the child is baptized with water. The baby then becomes a member of the Great Babylon religion of the Vatican. At this point the baby is supposed to be cleansed from all original sin, and made a child of God, and heir of heaven. The baby is then classified as "born again". The indelible mark on this babies soul is Satanic. The baby has actually received the mark of witchcraft and there is not much hope for a Roman Catholic that has been exposed to this heathen ceremony, until he leaves that system. Yeshua Himself said in **Rev. 18:4** ***"And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, "Come out of her, my people, that you may not participate in her sins and that you may not receive of her plagues;"*** The Jesus that this child is being baptized into is the other Jesus we were warned about in 2Cor. 11:4.

A famous Bishop Hay of Rome when asked the following question; what happens to a child who dies without baptism? replied; "if a young child were put to death for the sake of Christ, this would be to the baptism of blood, and carry it into heaven; but except in this case, as such infants are incapable of having the desire of baptism, with the other necessary dispositions, if they are not actually baptized with water, they cannot go to heaven". This statement is from the mouth of the serpent himself. This of course is unscriptural as per "Suffer the little children to come unto Me, and forbid them not; for of such is the kingdom of heaven", written in our good Book. The practice of making the form of a cross on an infants forehead is also from the pagans. The cross form, called the Tau, was the symbol used by heathens of old in their rituals.

The "sprinkling of water" type baptism is actually a heathen practice. It is an abomination to Yahveh. It

originates not at all Biblically but from heathen worship practices in the Babylonian Temples of the various pagan god's. The sprinkling of blood or water was used in ceremonies of various dedications.

It was also used by one of Christianity's greatest camouflage so-called Believers, Emperor Constantine. Constantine, although thought by many to be a Believer, was a Sun god worshipper until he laid in his deathbed. Apparently he suddenly had a change of thought about his pagan Sun god and wanted to receive Yahveh. No-one knows for sure if he ever did, but he then had a baptism ceremony. He was sprinkled with water in his deathbed, because he couldn't get up. Many think that this is the origin of sprinkling. Holy water, which we see used in modern churches today, is also from heathen worship practices (1Cor. 10:21).

In most Christian pagan palaces children are sprinkled with supposed Holy Water over a basin of some kind. In many of these religious organizations, especially in the Roman Catholic Churches, you will see the demonic Acronym "IHS" on the pedestal they do this occult activity on. The "IHS" stands for "Isis", "Horus", and "Set/Seb", the Satanic Trinity. This is the same IHS stamped on the Catholic host bread used during Mass. It has for thousands of years represented the three Egyptian gods of the Satanic Trinity. IHS is the surname of Bacchus the sun god, commonly called Tammuz. IHS or IES is the abbreviated form of IHSOUS (Iesous) in Greek.



The reality is, the leaders of these so-called Christian churches, who claim to love The Holy One Of Israel, are offering these babies up to Satan, that should be enough to make anyone sick to the stomach.

The true Hebrew meaning of Biblical Baptism meant that the "old Adam was washed away and the new man was brought forth". This is not regeneration, it is what you might call "born again" from the womb. This Mikvah meant that you were completely re-born, and therefore the immersion in water represented the mothers womb. True "People of the way" Baptism, was used for repentance, and for having the old Adam washed away, not like the heathens.

In the Babylonian practices, baptism took place for initiates into the mysteries of the gods and goddesses. The Chaldean pagans required baptism for initiates prior to any instruction being received. Children for them, were baptized into the worship of Osiris, Odin, Isis, Mithra, etc., without ever consenting to it. The practice of baptizing infants was and is still to this day of pagan origin.
